EPPING EASTWOOD TIGERS V REDBACKS 6/7/13 PEATEY SEALS IT FOR TIGERS.

In fine dry conditions at Boronia, the Tigers were hoping to put the disappointment of their last game behind them & welcomed back Matt Corringham from injury but were still missing a few regulars due to injury & suspension.

The game started slowly but Tigers got into their stride & were putting pressure on the Redbacks defence. Narian Chetty was proving a handful for the defence, but poor finishing was saving the Redbacks rather than their keeper. Finally on 20mins following good work from Kane Swan the ball broke for Matt Peatey who hammered home a "peach" from 20 metres. Tigers continued to dominate for the rest

of the half but it remained 1-0 at half time.

The second half continued in the same vein with Tigers midfield in control & their defence rarely troubled. This pressure paid off for Matt Peatey to again find the back of the net on 55 mins with a well placed effort from 12 metres. The scoring was completed on 70 mins by Josh De Kelly with a clever lob over the advancing keeper following a beautifully timed through ball from Matt Peatey. The substitutions started on 75 mins & it appeared that the Tigers were content with their days work. Chetty was denied a goal near the end for offside which was unfortunate as his efforts throughout deserved reward. "Best on Ground" went to Matt Peatey.
